HISTORY

The Pudding Club was founded in 1985 to prevent the demise of the great British Pudding, at a time when restaurants seemed to offer only tiny portions of Frozen Cheesecake and tasteless Gateaux. Today the Pudding Club and its supporters can claim that their efforts have re-established such delights as Jam Roly Poly, Syrup Sponge, Spotted Dick and Bread and Butter pudding as favourites throughout the country.

MEETINGS

These fun evenings start at 7.30pm with a welcome drink in the lounge and an introduction to the rules and history of the club. Then, after a choice of three modest main courses the main business of the evening begins when seven traditional puddings are paraded with ceremony - and cheers of anticipation. These will include well known favourites like Sticky Toffee and Date as well as the more unusual such as Sussex Pond and Lord Randall's Pudding. Each pudding is accompanied by lashings of Custard and you can indulge in as many as you want - within the rules - until you say "I'm full!" Afterwards relax with coffee and tea while casting your vote for "Pudding of the Night". Meetings are great fun and very popular. Places can be reserved at £30 per guest and a non-refundable deposit of £15 per guest will secure your place and ensure a memorable evening.

PUDDING CLUB BREAKS

Enjoy a unique break at the Home of The Pudding Club. Arrive on Friday in time to attend the Pudding Club meeting without the worry of driving home after too much custard! Stay overnight in your en-suite room and help yourself to English breakfast before exploring the area. You could visit Stratford-upon-Avon, Chipping Campden or Broadway or perhaps walk off some of the calories on the Cotswold hills. We have maps of course, and we can even hire a bike for you if you want. Dinner on Saturday is a sumptuous, elegant affair in the award winning restaurant, accompanied by our pianist at the baby grand. Breakfast on Sunday brings the weekend to a close... unless you'd like to stay Sunday night at a special rate. A Pudding Club break is £195 per night for a twin or double room for 2 guests; you can stay in a superior room or a unique Pudding Room from £225 per night. Double rooms for single occupancy are £130 per night, based on a two night stay.

Do I have to be a member?
